BILBAO – LEÓN

DAY 1. (FRIDAY)

BILBAO-ESPINOSA DE LOS MONTEROS

- Baggage pick-up from 14:00 to 15:00 at La Concordia Station in Bilbao; a unique modernist building dating back to 1902 that is one of the most authentic heritage sites in Bilbao from the Belle Époque Era. At 15:00, meet all of your travel companions at a welcome talk on board the train. Once settled on board, the La Robla Express heads towards Sotoscueva, to visit the Ojo Guareña karst complex, formed by more than 100 kilometres of galleries and declared a Natural Monument. The next stop is Espinosa de los Monteros, a beautiful village in the Burgos Merindades, where you will have dinner. Overnight in Espinosa.



while chatting with our travelling companions or simply enjoying the magnificent views passing by the windows.

In the La Robla Express' compartments, every centimetre is made use of and fully equipped with two bunk beds, wardrobe, piped music and adjustable air-conditioner, as well as a small

DAY 2. (SATURDAY)

ESPINOSA DE LOS MONTEROS-CISTIerna

- Enjoy your first breakfast to the click-clack of the iron rails and beautiful scenery on the way to Mataporquera. From here, a coach will take you to the breath-taking landscapes of the Romanesque Palencia, Carrión de los Condes, with many historical heritage sites to visit and enjoy. Enjoy the town in your own way with free time before the tour continues to Canal de Castilla and Frómista, with its impressive Romanesque church of San Martín. Free time and lunch. In the afternoon, continue on a journey back in time with a visit to the Roman Villa of La Olmeda and its magnificent collection of mosaics. Back on board, the next stop on the La Robla Express is Cistierna, where you will have dinner and spend the night.

DAY 3. (SUNDAY)

CISTIerna-LEÓN

- What better way to start the day than breakfast to the click-clack of the rails with beautiful landscapes flashing by on board the La Robla Express. The next stop on our adventure is San Feliz (literally, Saint Happy!), it's sure to be a fun day! From here we go by coach to visit the city of León to explore its historical centre, San Isidoro and the Cathedral. Free time, to end the trip at approximately 14:00.

LEÓN – BILBAO

DAY 1. (FRIDAY)

LEÓN-CISTIerna

- Baggage pick-up from 14:00 to 15:00 at the FEVE station in León. The coach will then take you back to San Feliz, where the La Robla Express awaits. Accommodation and transfer to Matallana. From here, the luxury coach will take you on a scenic ride through the spectacular Hoces de Vegacervera to visit the Valporquero Cave, famous for its stalactites, stalagmites and flowstones in fascinating shapes, and also for its impressive 'Great Space' of 100,000 m3 of underground space. Next, hop back on the train as it heads to Cistierna for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 2. (SATURDAY)

CISTIerna-ESPINOSA DE LOS MONTEROS

- Start the day with another leisurely breakfast on the way to our next stop; Guardo, in the magical lands of Palencia. From here, enjoy a coach ride to the La Olmeda Roman villa, with its magnificent collection of mosaics, and then discover some of the finest Romanesque art collections in Europe in the towns of Carrión de los Condes and Frómista, where we will have lunch. After visiting the impressive San Martin temple and the Castilla

DAY 3. (SUNDAY)
